Explorers Event: Folklore Art Gallery

The Folklore Art Gallery is situated on Zayed the First Street in Khalidiya area. It is a small unassuming building, though when you walk inside, there is a breadth of modern works balanced among antiques.

The proprietor gave AWN group a wonderful presentation on local artist works as well as regional artist works. There were old photographs, prints, paintings and also modern colorful renditions of calligraphy that could be purchased, framed or unframed. If you choose, you can have a personalised calligraphic artistic rendition of your name.

Also on display were antique coffee pots (brass pots handcrafted with detail that have lasted for many years), and he described the uses for brewing coffee, a tradition from the middle east, still used with the locals.

There were also antique silver jewelry on display from UAE and Oman; silver coins were used to make some of the pieces on display.

Their colorful screen prints make great gifts or tokens of remembrance. This was a gallery well worth visiting.

We learn something new every week as she shares her knitting knowledge and it's been a great way to make new friends.

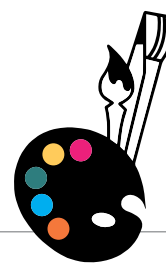
I nearly didn't go to the newcomers' coffee because I felt nervous, I'm so glad I did.

SOCIAL BRIDGE

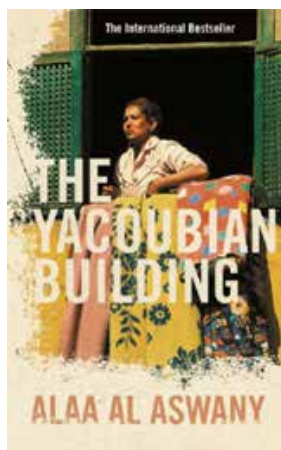

This controversial bestselling novel in the Arab world reveals the political corruption, sexual repression, religious extremism, and modern hopes of Egypt today.

All manner of flawed and fragile humanity reside in the Yacoubian Building, a once-elegant temple of Art Deco splendor now slowly decaying in the smog and bustle of downtown Cairo: a fading aristocrat and self-proclaimed “scientist of women”; a sultry, voluptuous siren; a devout young student, feeling the irresistible pull toward fundamentalism; a newspaper editor helplessly in love with a policeman; a corrupt and corpulent politician, twisting the Koran to justify his desires. Did you know that Abu Dhabi will be hosting the 2018 Special Olympics MENA Games and the 2019 Special Olympics World Games? You can be a volunteer!

The Abu Dhabi Special Olympics is overseen by a Higher Committee chaired by HE Mohamad Abdulla Al Junaibi, Executive Director of Protocol at the Abu Dhabi Crown Prince Court. Founded in 1968 by Eunice Kennedy Shriver, the Special Olympics benefits not only the athletes taking part, but their families and the community, leaving a legacy of acceptance and understanding of those with intellectual disability.

There are a variety of volunteer roles in all different areas, from technology to operations, events and sports. Volunteers are asked to commit themselves to 5 shifts across the games from 15th-23rd March, 2018 (dates depend on the specific roles) and transport from key locations and food/drink will be provided.

Divisions:

Delegation Services – perfect for speakers of other languages and those with VIP experience. Potentially the hardest roles of all, as it does require a lot of commitment and you will be the face of the games for our VIPs.

Operations – ensuring the Games run smoothly and solve any problems; our very own superheroes! Roles include announcers, stage managers and logistics support.

Medical – medical screening and assistance for the volunteers. For this, we need nurses, optometrists, audiologists and other clinicians, plus anyone with an interest in medical care.

Guest Services – the friendly face of the games; meeting and greeting, registration and providing general advice during the games.

Events – our special events throughout the Games include the Torch Run and Award Ceremonies. Everyone can get involved here!

Communications – a great opportunity for journalists, videographers, animators, designers and illustrators to get their name published locally and internationally

Sport – with 16 sports in the MENA Games and 24 in the World Games, individuals with a sporting background would be beneficial, but we can train most people in the basics

Technology – network, application and desktop support.
